Minutes:

- 1. Dr. R. Ravindran, Principal began sharing the information regarding the mechanism of grievance submission and the resolution techniques for the issues raised by SC/ST students. He also stressed the need for providing safer environment for all the SC/ST students in the campus.
- 2. He has also reviewed for any recent reported incidents and found satisfactory as there were no complaints received.
- 3. The committee then discussed about a range of harassment and discriminatory practices reported in and around institutions, common places, etc., and advised the committee members to address to all students not to indulge in unnecessary activities.
- 4. The committee highlighted the scholarship scheme available for SC/ST students to pursue their education.

- 5. Guidelines, eligibility criteria and other requirements for SC/ST scholarship were discussed. It was also informed to go through www.scholarships.gov.in for detailed information.
- 6. The committee discussed about the One Time Registration (OTR) number and registration process which is required to receive 60% of the Central Government funds share.
- 7. Prime Minister's Scholarship Scheme (PMSS) and its reimbursement for the Academic Year 2023 2024 was briefly discussed among the members of the committee.
- 8. The committee advised to engage the office staff to provide all the necessary information related to the guidelines, eligible criteria and procedure of applying for SC/ST scholarship which can be disseminated to students who are interested to apply for the scheme.
- 9. While concluding the meeting, the chairperson mentioned about the need to conduct awareness programs on harassment prevention and safeguard the students welfare.
